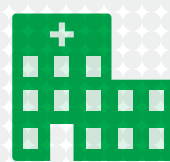


## BENEFITS OF TELEMEDICINE

- **Aerodigestive** (upperdigestive tract, airway and respiratory/pulmonary disorders)
- **Allergy and immunology** (allergic and immunodeficiency disorders)
- **Hepatology** (liver disease)
- **Interventional radiology** (clinic to improve pre- and postprocedure care for patients)
- **Nephrology** (kidney disease)
- **Neurology** (ketogenic diet)
- **Otolaryngology** (ear, nose and throat)
- **Psychology** (related to autism spectrum disorder)\*\*
- **Pulmonology** (lung disease)
